One last update:

Ontaratue D-39 (G02A012)

- A Final Plan for D-39 was submitted in May 2013,
- Subsequent inspections by both, Chinooks' environmental consultant (Enviro-Search/MWH) and the Department of Lands has shown the site is stable (no evidence of any subsidence) with good vegetative cover.
- In 2017 additional soil samples and surface water samples were collected from D-39 and submitted for laboratory analysis, as requested by the Department.
- The results of the soil sampling from the sump area and the background control area were comparable, and there were no exceedances of the CCME guidelines.
- Water samples from 2 cells with ponding water were also analyzed and none of these parameters exceeded the CCME guidelines.
- The results of the 2017 sampling were reported by Envirosearch and submitted to the Department of Lands on May 29, 2018.

Based on the site conditions, and the previously completed site inspections and investigations completed at D-39, Chinook believes the Department has the documentation required to recommend closure of the site.

If there is additional information missing that is required for review of the submitted final plan, please let us know and we will work with you to ensure it is provided.

It is our hope that file closure for all 3 remaining sites : D-39 (G02A012), N-73 (G02A013) and C-36 (G02A011) can be provided.
