Re: Issuance of a Type "A" Land Use Permit – G 08 H 004
Gwich'in Tribal Council
Gwich'in Camp on East Branch of the Mackenzie River
Camp and Fuel Storage

Attached is Land Use Permit G 08 H 004, which has been approved and issued by the Gwich'in Land and Water Board (the Board) to the Gwich'in Tribal Council in accordance with the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act for the period commencing May 20, 2008, and ending on May 20, 2013.

Be advised that a copy of this letter, along with the Land Use Permit, all inspection reports and correspondence related thereto, will be filed in the Public Registry at the offices of the Gwich'in Land and Water Board in Inuvik, NT, as per the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act. This is intended to keep all interested parties informed of the manner in which the Land Use Permit requirements are being met. All Public Registry material will be considered if an amendment to the Land Use Permit is requested.

It is imperative that all persons working under the authority of this Land Use Permit are aware of and will adhere to the conditions as stated in permit.

I would like to point out a couple of conditions:

The Permittee shall provide, in writing, to a Land Use Inspector and the Board, at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to commencement of this land use operation, the following information:

- (a) person, or persons, in charge of the field operation to whom notices, orders, and reports may be served;*
- (b) alternates; and*
- (c) all methods for contacting the above person(s).*

The Permittee shall submit a progress report to a Land Use Inspector and the Board every six (6) months during the course of this land use operation.

Further, the Board would appreciate written confirmation from the Town of Inuvik giving their approval that the Gwich'in Tribal Council can deposit waste at the Inuvik Waste Facilities.

In addition, there was a concern that the waste water discharge may have an impact on the permafrost in the area, so the Board advises the Gwich'in Tribal Council to be aware of this potential impact.

The full cooperation of Mackenzie Valley Construction Ltd. is anticipated and appreciated.
