Please note that a Land use Permit was issued to the Department of Transportation for Fuel Storage, Camp and Land Farm on July 10, 2013. As part of the letter of issuance, the GLWB requested that DOT provide a Remediation Plan to the Gwich'in Land and Water Board (GLWB) by October 31st 2013 for review and approval. AANDC was advised by GLWB that this has not yet been received to date.

You are therefore ordered to submit to the GLWB and AANDC a Remediation Plan for the activities occurring under Land Use Permit G13H004 no later than August 01, 2014.

Section 86(1) of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act (MVRMA) states the following:

86. (1) Where an inspector has reasonable grounds to believe that a permitted use of land has resulted in or is likely to result in an adverse effect on the environment, the inspector may, in accordance with the regulations, order the permittee in writing to take such measures as the inspector considers reasonable to mitigate, remedy or prevent the adverse effect.



Should this order be ignored Section 92(1) may apply.

92(1) Every person who contravenes any provision of the regulations, any condition of a permit or an order of an inspector under subsection 86(1) or(2) is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$15,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or to both.
