Please note that this is a second request to provide pre and post data for quarry permit 2016QP0016 and material to be removed from site at km 251 and would like to bring to your attention that as per your quarry permit conditions the following items are still to be complied with.

*"12. Prior to the tenth of each month, the Permittee shall submit a report to the Land Use Inspector at (867) 777-2090, indicating the quantity of material quarried and the quantity of material removed from the site. Failure to submit the monthly report within the indicated time frame may result in cancellation of this permit as per section 9(6) of the regulations.*

*13. Upon expiry of the permit, the Permittee must submit a Final Plan to the Land Use Inspector for reconciliation and approval. Failure to submit a Final Plan within 60 days of project completion may result in rejection of future Quarry Permit Applications until rectified.*

*14. A permittee who over-quarries may be ineligible for future quarry permits for a twelve month period and additional legal action may be taken by the Land Use Inspector under the Territorial Quarrying Regulations.*

*15. This permit is subject to the provisions of the Territorial Quarrying Regulations and the*
