**Explanatory Remarks -**

**Km 251:**

During this inspection it was observed that little removal of material was done, the previous inspection report dated August 27, 2020 showed stockpiles that were to be removed and further indicated that removal was based on the site being a multi user site and the stock piles limited safe maneuverability for other contractors. There was been numerous requests over the past year by the Department of Lands to have the stock piles removed, of which little work has been done.

Your current quarry permit number 2019QP0038 has expired on Sept. 12 2020 and is no longer valid. Your permit was for a volume of 5000cm. Your quarry survey showed that 2906cm was blasted, leaving 2094cm to be reimbursed to Bobs Welding.

### ENVIRONMENTAL INSPECTION REPORT

A letter for refund for quarry permit 2019QP0038 will be sent to headquarters for requisition for the remaining 2094cm.

As per your Land Use Permit under part "A" Scope of Permit item number4 states:

"This permit is only valid in conjunction with a valid Quarry Permit from the GNWT Department of Lands."

We would like to remind you again that Km 251 is a multi-user pit and also of the numerous requests pointed out on previous inspection reports dated; Feb. 19, 2020, April 24, 2020, June 15, 2020 and July 14, 2020. It is recommended that these observations be actioned on immediately, to ensure other permit holders have an easy access and safe maneuverability into and out of their work areas.

As your quarry permit is expired no work is to be done until such time a new quarry permit is issued and this would have to be applied for at a low volume of 100 cm. This would allow you to work under your Land Use Permit and carry out work to remove your material. No future Blasting or excavating will be permitted under the new Quarry Permit being applied for. Please note that the application fees and royalties would still be required.

This permit is subject to the provisions of the Territorial Quarrying Regulations and the conditions set out herein. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Regulations and the conditions prescribed in this permit may result in cancellation of the permit in accordance with Section 9(6) of the Territorial Quarrying Regulations without prior notice to the Permittee.

Also just a reminder that Land Use Permit G16Q004 will expire on May 25, 2021.
