**TERMS AND CONDITIONS
INCLUDED IN AND FORMING PART OF
TIMBER CUTTING LICENCE #TL002017**

The following terms and conditions are included in **Timber Cutting Licence #TL002017** pursuant to Section 36.1 (1) of the *Forest Management Regulations*, issued to Deninu Kue Holdings Ltd. at Fort Resolution, NWT.

Location and Area

1. The Timber Cutting LICENCE HOLDER, herein after referred to as the LICENCE HOLDER, shall harvest timber only in the Slave River Forest Management Unit (FMU) U/2 in stands; Map sheet 08H-002: stands 83c, 84s, 85s, 86s.

Time

2. The LICENCE HOLDER shall not commence timber operations until the Superintendent, South Slave Region, Department of Environment and Natural Resources has approved an Annual Operating Plan, for the current year of the licence.
3. The LICENCE HOLDER shall advise the Forest Management Officer (herein after called an Officer) at the Department of Environment and Natural Resources at Fort Resolution, NT at phone number (867) 394-4596, 24 (twenty-four) hours in advance of the start of timber operations.
4. The LICENCE HOLDER shall in a progressive manner, and, within three months of the expiration of this licence, remove, demolish, or otherwise dispose of, in a manner satisfactory to the Forest Management Supervisor;
 - a) All buildings or structures and equipment constructed or brought to the licence area under the authority of this licence.
 - b) All debris resulting from cutting and removal of timber.
 - c) All timber harvested under this licence.

Operating Plan

5. The LICENCE HOLDER shall carry out his timber operation in accordance with an approved Annual Operating Plan.
6. In addition to the terms and conditions of the Timber Cutting Licence, the LICENCE HOLDER shall abide by terms and conditions of an approved Annual Operating Plan.

Machinery and Equipment

7. All machinery and equipment associated with this operation shall be confined to those routes or areas designated in an approved Annual Operating Plan.
8. Should deviation from an approved Annual Operating Plan be required while conducting this operation, the operator must obtain approval in writing prior to implementation of any change.
9. The LICENCE HOLDER shall not establish any additional facilities within the LICENCE area without prior written approval.
10. The LICENCE HOLDER shall use only the equipment specified in an approved Annual Operating Plan.

Access Roads, Skid Trails and Landings

11. The LICENCE HOLDER
 - a) shall use existing roads, trails and seismic lines as access routes where directed to do so by an Officer
 - b) shall not construct any road greater than ten (10) metres in width, unless otherwise approved by an Officer
12. The LICENCE HOLDER shall not construct skid trails greater than seven (7) metres in width.
13. The LICENCE HOLDER shall not clear or construct landings greater than 0.4 hectares in size including the area required for debris and overburden piles.

- 14. The LICENCE HOLDER shall limit landings according to the following criteria;
 - a) A maximum of one (1) landing per block for a harvest area of less than 8 ha;
 - b) A maximum of two (2) landing per block for a harvest area of eight (8) hectares or greater and less than fifteen (15) hectares;
 - c) One (1) additional landing per block for every ten (10) hectares of harvest area in excess of fifteen hectares
- 15. The LICENCE HOLDER may increase the number of landings at the discretion of an Officer where such authorization is provided in writing in advance of clearing of the landing.
- 16. The LICENCE HOLDER shall restore landings as specified in an approved Annual Operating Plan, or as specified by an Officer.

Timber Harvesting and Utilization Standards

- 17. The LICENCE HOLDER
 - a) Shall carry out harvesting in accordance with the prescriptions specified and approved for the harvest blocks in an approved Annual Operating Plan.
 - b) Shall harvest all trees felled with a diameter breast height (dbh) of 18 centimetres and greater
 - c) Shall harvest all trees felled to a top diameter outside bark of not more than 15 centimetres
- 18. The *Forest Management Regulations* specify that the LICENCE HOLDER shall not leave stumps higher than 30 centimetres (12 inches) above the average ground level.
- 19. The LICENCE HOLDER shall carry out timber harvesting in a progressive manner and such that no merchantable timber is left behind during the harvesting operations; except as directed in writing by an Officer.
- 20. Where timber is left, which, in the opinion of an Officer should have been cut, the Officer may require the LICENCE HOLDER to return and harvest such trees in such time as the Officer deems necessary.

Brush and Debris Disposal

21. Unless otherwise stated in an approved Annual Operating Plan the LICENCE HOLDER
- a) shall as rapidly as the cutting operation progresses remove all limbs from the trees which are felled.
 - i) All limbs shall be removed within the designated cut block, before the log is removed to the landing
 - b) shall remove all trees in full length to the designated landing, where tops shall be removed and piled in the center of said landing after merchantable materials have been removed and before the landings are abandoned
 - c) shall lop and scatter and make to lie flat on the ground in a manner satisfactory to an Officer all unmerchantable trees
 - d) shall buck all tree lengths or portions of tree lengths (longer than six feet (1.8 m)) remaining in the harvest blocks after harvesting is completed, into six foot (1.8 m) lengths.
 - e) The LICENCE HOLDER shall fell and remove all leaner trees and debris from residual timber stands as soon as is reasonable, or as directed by an Officer.
 - f) Where an Officer is of the opinion that refuse or debris on the licence area is excessive, the Officer may order the LICENCE HOLDER to take what ever action the Officer deems necessary to eliminate the problem, in such time as the Officer deems necessary.
 - g) The LICENCE HOLDER shall keep all garbage and debris in a covered metal container until disposed of.
 - h) The LICENCE HOLDER shall dispose of all debris at landings as specified in the approved Annual Operating Plan.

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Prevention and Control of Forest Fires

22. The LICENCE HOLDER shall not commence or continue any activities under this Timber Cutting Licence during the Closed Season, until a Plan for the Prevention and Control of Forest Fires has been submitted and approved.
23. The LICENCE HOLDER shall implement the approved Plan for the Prevention and Control of Forest Fires, prior to commencing any activities under this licence during the Closed Season
24. The LICENCE HOLDER shall maintain a three-metre fireguard to mineral soil around all debris piles, which are to be burned.
25. No debris shall be spread within three metres of the edge of any clearings or cut block.
26. The LICENCE HOLDER shall supervise all fires until such time as the fire is out.
27. Spark arrestors are required on all chainsaws, chimneys, engines and incinerators in use during the Closed Season.
28. The *Forest Protection Act (R.S.N.W.T. 1988.c.F-10)* provides that no person shall set out a fire during the Closed Season unless the LICENCE HOLDER has obtained a Permit To Burn.
29. During the Closed Season, all fires shall be reported to the area office of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources in Fort Resolution, NT (867) 394-4586 or to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources; Forest Fire Centre at 1-800-661-0800.

Protection of Wildlife, Fisheries habitat and Places of Recreational Scenic or Ecological Value

30. The LICENCE HOLDER
 - a) shall take measures to ensure protection of Ecological Values, as specified in terms and conditions included in an approved Annual Operating Plan, or as specified by an Officer.

- b) shall not conduct any operation in areas designated as sensitive or requiring special protection, as specified by an Officer, as identified in the Pre-Harvest Ecological Assessment, or as specified in an approved prescription for a harvest block.

Damage to Residual Stands

31. The LICENCE HOLDER shall avoid causing excessive damage to residual stands of timber.
- a) The LICENCE HOLDER shall pay Timber Cutting Charges and Reforestation for any volume of timber unnecessarily damaged, as determined by an Officer.
- b) Such volume damaged will be included as part of but not in addition to the authorized harvest for the period.
32. The LICENCE HOLDER shall limit the number of access roads or trails avoiding excessive damage to residual stands.
33. The LICENCE HOLDER shall limit the transporting of equipment to access roads and trails only.

Matters Not Inconsistent With The Regulations

Petroleum Fuel Storage

34. The LICENCE HOLDER shall not allow petroleum products to spread to surrounding lands or into water bodies
35. All spills shall be reported immediately to the 24-hour spill line at (867) 920-8130.

Timber Scaling

36. All timber cut and harvested shall be measured at the LICENCE HOLDER's expense by a timber scaler licensed in the Northwest Territories.
37. All timber shall be scaled in accordance with the approved Scaling Manual of the Northwest Territories, and in accordance with a signed Scaling Agreement between the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Government of the Northwest Territories (the Department) and the LICENCE HOLDER.

- 38. All timber harvested shall be scaled within one month of harvest, and, at minimum, when the timber harvested is removed from the harvest site.
- 39. The LICENCE HOLDER shall
 - a) furnish the Department with a scaling summary in a form acceptable to the Department, showing volumes of timber scaled and transported during each month
 - b) submit the scaling summary every month during the term of the LICENCE to the Forest Management Officer at the Department of Environment and Natural Resources in Fort Resolution, NT, not later than the tenth day of the month following the month for which it is due.

Letter of Clearance

- 40. The obligations of the LICENCE HOLDER with respect to this operation do not cease until the LICENCE HOLDER is in possession of a letter of clearance from the Forest Management Supervisor.
- 41. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions precludes the LICENCE HOLDER from obligations under the Territorial Lands Act and other applicable Federal and Territorial Legislation.
- 42. The LICENCE HOLDER shall process all timber harvested; into the products licenced, within twelve (12) months of the harvest of the timber.
