**Forest Management Application FA - 002265
Application to amend Timber Cutting Permit TP-002256
Gus Pasowisty of a G&G Wood Products
Near Fort Resolution**

G&G Wood Products (Gus Pasowisty) of Fort Resolution has applied to amend Timber Cutting Permit TP002256 to increase the level of harvest to 5000 cubic metres of spruce saw logs and to add new harvest areas from areas along the Fort Resolution Highway near Fort Resolution.

The activity will be occurring in Akaitcho First Nations Traditional Territory and the activity may require a land use permit. The activity is subject to preliminary screening pursuant to the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*.

The Department of Resources, Wildlife and Economic Development has requested review and comment from cooperative agencies and affected First Nations on the application in accordance with the Department's commitments to consultation on forest development activities under interim measures agreements, requirements set in legislation under the *Forest Management Act* and *Regulations* of the NWT, and requirements set out in legislation under the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*.



The Department has set the deadline for comments to be **November 23, 2004**. Subsequently, the Department will review comments and input, and its own environmental assessments and make a decision on whether to approve the amendment or refuse to approve the amendment. It is our intent to undertake this follow-up action by November 26, 2004.
