Hi Shannon,

I wanted to clarify that the GMRP considers that May 31st version of the QRA to meet the requirements of Measure 5 which states, “the Developer will commission an independent quantitative risk assessment to be completed before the Project receives regulatory approvals.”

The purpose of the engagement is to help rights and stakeholders interpret results and to validate findings. It is important to the Project that we continue to be responsive to rights and stakeholder input and for that reason the Project has indicated that we will accept written comments from rights and stakeholders as well as feedback and responses during engagement. It is possible that the feedback we receive during this process could result in improvements to a subsequent version of the QRA or more likely that this feedback will be carried forward in to either design or long-term management and monitoring planning. Therefore, the GMRP submits that the May 31, 2020 version, which has been through substantial internal QAQC and will be ready for external review including rightsholders, stakeholders and the MVLWB meets Measure 5.
