Shannon and Tim,

The Giant Mine Remediation Project is planning a drilling program, which will begin in mid-October. The project has identified a need to bring in approximately 2,000 m³ of borrow materials for borehole drill pads, upgrades or repairs to borehole access roads or other infrastructure improvements.

This material will be sourced from off-site and will be tested to ensure that aggregate materials used on site do not leach or cause deleterious runoff. The contractor will be required, as per the contract specifications, to source an aggregate material that is non-metal leaching, Non-acid generating or Potentially Acid Generating (PAG) and non-Tailings earth materials. Prior to bringing material to site the contractor will provide documentation on the acid-base accounting (ABA) sampling and testing that was conducted to confirm that it is Non-acid generating or Potentially Acid Generating (PAG).

The volumes of material are minimal, but are necessary in order to avoid delays to this investigation drilling program, which will inform our final designs. The Giant Mine Remediation Project is requesting that this notification serves as an interim process during the care and maintenance phase of the project, prior to submission of the Borrow Materials and Explosives Monitoring and Management Plan to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board for approval.
