Good morning Michael,

I reviewed the Town's response when I returned to the office this morning, and would like to provide some points of clarification. Shannon, these should also be for the public record as well please, and we will include them in our presentation next week.

I won't reiterate points which are already in our intervention, but do need to clarify the substance of a telephone conversation January 14th between Michael and myself, whereby corrections to the Town's letter of January 14, 2010 are needed.

2.3.1 Bioassay testing. If the water licence continues to require bioassay testing (which Environment Canada recommends), EC agreed to assist with the provision of testing rainbow trout at no cost to the Town for the next two years. The Town would be responsible for sample collection and shipping costs. This would allow the Town time to budget for testing, and the Town would be responsible for all costs from 2012 forward.

2.3.3 EC has not completed work which would assist the Town in determining how their measured levels of BOD would relate to cBOD in this system. Therefore, EC would find it difficult to make any recommendations to the Board in respect of an appropriate cBOD limit should the licence move to that as a regulated, rather than a monitored, parameter as suggested by the Town in their January 14th letter.
