The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) has considered the request of the Board based on its mandated responsibilities under the *Environmental Protection Act*, the *Forest Management Act*, the *Forest Protection Act* and the *Wildlife Act*, and confirms that ENR will attend the pre-hearing conference and provides the following information as requested by the Board.
