I know this isn't on an actual form but this is the plan for the next couple of days:

Good evening Albert, Today's operations went well, and I believe we made significant progress with the dump fire. Due to the progress, we made today we will keep operations as they are with the digging out of burnt and burning materials and applying water to them. I am estimating that the fire extends down about 12-25' and the plan at this time is to work the fire until it is extinguished. We will be running with 1 Tender, 1 Engine, a Rehab Unit, and FD pickup truck and a strike team of 5 HRFD members.

We are holding off on trenching around the fire for at least 1 more day, but we are holding that in our back pockets as plan B

For your information, we have flowed 122,000 gallons of water on the fire so far and have put in 336 manhours.
