- Fiddlers Lake Treatment System Plan (D. 15 and Sched. 2, item 3))
- Sewage Effluent Characterization Study (D. 20)
- Sewage Disposal Facilities O&M Plan (H.1 and Sched. 4, item 1)

An update on the expected timeline for submission of these documents would be appreciated by the end of the week if possible. As you know, several other studies and plans rely on the outcome of the first two documents, so it would be helpful for the Board to understand how the City intends to fit all the pieces together.
