Hello Todd,

In answer to your questions:

1. The City's current water licence does not have criteria for ammonia other than to have a plan in place to reduce the loading to 5mg/L by 2008.
2. We are asking for an increased limit from the 5mg/L to 15mg/L in order that we are held to the same standards as the rest of Canada. Our effluent consistently has higher ammonia levels with lower pH levels which maintains a non-toxic effluent. The new limit we are requesting is for samples that coincide with low pH levels so that we continue to produce a non-toxic effluent.
3. I agree with you that this is very technical. The memo I sent out was a summary of a complex report from our consultant. The consultant's report is very difficult to understand and the recommendations we are asking for came about through both their report and meetings to discuss the new CCME MWWWE Strategy.

If you'd like to discuss this further, I am available to meet next week (other than Monday). If you have any other questions, please let me know.
