Technical Session Commitments – City of Yellowknife Water Licence Renewal Application

During the technical session held on November 12, 2009, the City of Yellowknife committed to providing answers, additional information, or clarification for the following items. This information is to be submitted to the Board for distribution to Reviewers on or before **November 23, 2009**.

Item 1

In a Dillon Consulting report it was indicated that three dams were installed which may have increased the lagoon height and provide for additional liquid holding capacity in the lagoon. The City of Yellowknife indicated that the increased lagoon height has been accounted for in the design lagoon capacity calculations.

Request

The City of Yellowknife indicated that the increased lagoon height has been accounted for in the design lagoon capacity calculations. Can the City of Yellowknife provide the new lagoon capacity estimate?

Item 2

The City of Yellowknife indicated that Transport Canada has provided a letter accepting the location of the new landfill cell in the quarry pits located north of the existing landfill.

Request

Provide the MVWLB with a copy of the Transport Canada letter.

Item 3

The City of Yellowknife was asked to provide explanation on how the calibration of a biological treatment model considered the seasonal variations in ammonia treatment. Additionally, the City of Yellowknife was asked if they see a need to predict phosphorous with a biological model and if so what would be the main sources and sinks of phosphorus that would be considered in the model.

Request

The City of Yellowknife indicated that they would provide further information on the calibration involving seasonal variation in ammonia and the prediction of phosphorous using a biological model.

Also, as a reminder, during this technical session, Reviewers were asked by the consultant for the Board to consider the need for parameter limits for the following:

- Landfill water discharge limits incorporating background concentrations values at landfill SNP locations for the current and future landfill expansion;
- Soil treatment criteria for the compost facility; and
- Surface water quality discharge.

It is also asked that Reviewers consider what limits the Board should use for ammonia. Comments on these matters can be included in written interventions which are due on **November 27, 2009**.

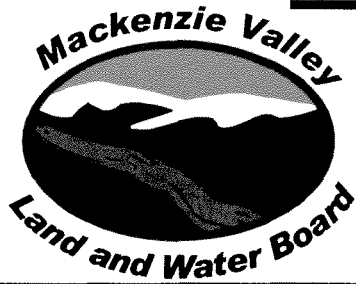
