On November 3, 2009 the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (Board) issued an agenda for the Technical Session to discuss matters pertaining to the renewal of Water Licence MV2009L3-0007. The Agenda gave a clear schedule for the morning and afternoon of November 6, 2009.

Environmental Protection staff of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) reviewed the agenda for matters they wished to discuss at the Technical Session. Based on the agenda these matters were scheduled for the afternoon.

Staff appeared at the required time in the afternoon (i.e. 1 pm) and were advised that all matters had been covered during the morning session and the Technical Session had adjourned. It appears that the adjournment was taken without due consideration of the specific schedule provided by the Board and that other parties wishing to discuss specific matters would attend for those portions of the Technical Session.

At this time, ENR requests that the Board schedule a technical meeting to replace the afternoon session that was cancelled without notification.

For future technical sessions, if Board staff finish the morning issues early, ENR suggests the staff break for the morning and resume in the afternoon, when the other experts are in attendance to discuss afternoon agenda items.
