Hi Alan,

Hope all is well in Liard. I received your faxed request for an emergency decant this afternoon via Maureen (attached). Please note my new contact info below.

With regard to your request, decant may proceed once the sample results are received and they meet the licence parameters as per Part D, Item 2 of the Water Licence. Sample results are to be provided to both the Inspector and the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board prior to commencement of decant operations.

As per Section 2(a) of the Surveillance Network Program in Water Licence MV2009L3-0025, I trust that the samples sent to CARO Laboratory Services for analysis included the following parameters:

pH	Ammonia-Nitrogen
Faecal Coliform	BOD ₅
Total Suspended Solids	Total Dissolved Solids
Conductivity	cBOD

In addition, please note that Section 2(a) of the Surveillance Network Program states that:

“Water at station number 1478-9 shall be sampled one week prior to discharge and weekly during discharge. If the decant period is less than seven days, station number 1478-9 shall be sampled on the first and last day of decant.”

Thus, I look forward to receiving the results of all required effluent samples as appropriate based on the above licence requirements and your decant schedule.

The Hamlet of Fort Liard hereby requests permission to perform an Emergency decant of sewage lagoon, Cell #3. Samples of effluent have been sent for testing to CARO Analytical Services to check if quality standards; as per Part D (2) of our water licence have been met. Copies of test results will be forwarded on their receipt. This decant operation will be necessary due to high lagoon levels after the spring thaw and recent periods of rain. This decant will need to be performed to avoid dyke overflow.

On its completion, cell 1-2 and 2-3 transfers will be performed to free up lagoon space for their continuing operations.
