- 1) Once a request to change the compliance date is received, a standard review process would be initiated. i.e., review period, proponent response, Board decision. No preliminary screening is required.
- 2) Time period would likely be 4-6 weeks (from submission) for a decision (though this may vary, depending on the extent of comments received on the request).
- 3) This request, though relating to similar issues, would be a separate proceeding.
- 4) This compliance date change can be made without ministerial approval.

As these issues are subject to an ongoing proceeding, meetings need to be more formal than the proposed chat. If you have any further questions, please feel free to forward in writing, or we can set up a meeting that would have summary minutes prepared. I am currently available most of next week.
