Thanks for the heads up. I just tried to reach you by phone; didn't realize you were away until next week (at which point I will be away – returning to the office on the 11<sup>th</sup>).

In addition to the extension request, I also wanted to talk to you about the meeting in Fort Smith on July 19 about the Water Licence. I'm copying Miki here so that she can follow up with you next week; here are a few of the things we need to touch base on:

#### Meeting

- I'm in the process of putting together an agenda for the day, and we'll be sending it out in the next week. We're envisioning starting at 10:30 and ending at 3:00, with presentations in the morning and discussion in the afternoon. I wanted to give you a heads up that we have you down in the morning for a presentation on Town operations (status and plans); this will be helpful in setting the stage for discussions.
- At this point, it looks like a delegation from Fort Resolution will be attending (Hamlet, DKFN and Metis); when the meeting was planned for early June, Salt River First Nation, Smiths Landing First Nation and the NWT Metis Nation had also expressed interest; I'll be confirming their attendance in the next little while.
- Are there any other Town staff that are involved with operations under the WL that we should invite to the meeting?

#### Logistics

- In terms of the venue, are we able to meet somewhere at the Town Hall where there is a speaker phone available (we have a conference line we can use)?
- Myself, Miki, Heather Scott and Rebecca Chouinard will be coming in from the MVLWB for the day. I am hoping to connect with Wendy Bidwell regarding a possible site tour the day before or the day after, so at least 3 of us will need to figure out transportation to and from the airport on the 19<sup>th</sup>. Any advice on this, or might you be able to drive us?
- We're planning to cater lunch and arrive with some snacks; is there coffee/tea available at the Town Hall?

I'm also working on a summary table of WL requirements, which will hopefully serve as a useful tool for guiding discussion and then tracking submissions. It would be helpful to go over it with both you and Wendy before the 19<sup>th</sup>, to make sure it's an accurate reflection of the whole picture – I'll be in touch about that.
