My apologies, yes it should be station 567-6

River ice is inherently unstable due to changing currents and conditions under the ice and border ice tends to be particularly weak. Negotiating ice on a particularly large river, such as the Slave River with its associated size and flows, is an inherently unsafe activity made especially dangerous in this situation with rapids just upstream of the lagoon discharge. The Town of Fort Smith does not believe collecting samples at SNP 567-6 can be performed safely in the winter months due to the uncertain nature of the ice conditions on the Slave River in the sample area at any time. We therefore, again, request the sampling requirements for SNP 567-6 be revised to monthly during open water only.

- Our response:
 - River ice is inherently unstable due to changing currents and conditions under the ice and border ice tends to be particularly weak.
