Hello everyone,

Here are the details for the fuel move from Portage 55 at the Lac de Gras road camp to HW camp.

March 10 - 15th

100 drums of Jet fuel to mobilize on the iceroad to P55

Drums to be banded 4 on a pallet, upright

Once at P55 drums will be unloaded by Nuna and placed in a cleared out area

Spill kit to be included in shipment and kept with the fuel

March 15 - 30th

a bell 407 from Acasta helicopters will be based at Ekati

The helicopter will sling the drums to HW camp

Return trips will remove empty drums from HW camp

Empty drums will be removed from P55 via truck at the end of the ice road

The fuel will be stored on its side, with bungs at 9 and 3. We will place the fuel in the same location as the previous cache at HW camp in rows, with ample space to walk between the rows for inspection purposes.

A new spill kit will be sent in with the fuel and left at site

Fuel cache totals, co-ordinates and pictures will be provided once fuel is in place.

Fuel drums will be marked with Land use permit MV2012C0009
