ACCESSING THE DETTAH SEWAGE LAGOON

Thank you for your letter dated June 4. We appreciate the assurances that you have provided in that letter regarding accessing the Dettah Sewage Lagoon through your sub-contractor, Akaitcho Bay Trucking. We are prepared to accept the human waste from the washroom trailer at the Giant Mine site at the Dettah Sewage Lagoon under the following conditions:

- 1) there is adequate existing capacity in the sewage lagoon;
- 2) the waste is only human waste and it only comes from the 2000 gallon septic tank recently purchased for the washroom trailer; and,
- 3) only Akaitcho Bay Trucking transports the waste to the sewage lagoon.

We will inform Akaitcho Bay Trucking of these conditions and we will endeavour to contact your company should there be any capacity issues at the sewage lagoon that would prevent us from taking any further waste from your washroom trailer at the Giant Mine site.
