The Inspectors have reviewed the alternative dust suppression MSDS and have no concerns with the product being used as an alternative. Condition #16 of the land use permit requires you to provide at least seven days notification prior to the use of any chemicals that were not identified in the application so ensure that all contractors onsite are made aware of the timelines.

Also, condition #25 of the land use permit states that a change in chemicals may require a updated waste management plan to be sent to the Board. Please make sure to contact the Board to discuss this condition further.
