Incomplete Application - Mineral Exploration - Mon Gold Mine

The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) received your Application for Land Use Permit MV2013C0021 on November 18, 2013. MVLWB staff has determined that there is insufficient information to conduct a preliminary screening in accordance with paragraph 22(1)(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR). Please submit the following information so MVLWB staff can consider the Application complete and forward it for review:

1. Further detail is needed on the proposed operation (bulk sample, mineral exploration, mining, etc.);
2. Please provide additional information on the construction of the new ramp;
3. Please provide additional information on how the walls of the decline will be secured;
4. Further detail is needed on the storage of fuel at site;
5. In the Spill Contingency Plan clarification is needed on the following items:
 - a. What other permits and/or licences do you currently have;
 - b. It is mentioned that the camp is currently permitted, please provide who the camp is permitted under; and

- c. The contact numbers for New Discover Mines Ltd head office are incorrect, please provide the correct numbers.
6. Please provide details on the quality of the water being proposed for discharge from the mine, including the final location of the water;
7. Please provide further detail on where water will be withdrawn for the camp and drilling activities;
8. Please provide further detail on the location, routing, construction, maintenance and operation of the proposed winter road;
9. Please provide the estimated amount of water needed for the construction, maintenance and operation of the winter road;
10. Please provide the details as to where water will be withdrawn for use in the construction, maintenance and operation of the winter road;
11. Please provide the mineral lease, mineral claims and any other applicable rights to the area;
12. What will be done with the rock from the development of the decline?
13. What are the geochemical properties of the rock?
14. What is the estimated volume of rock to be removed from the decline?
15. Please provide one hard copy of the Application and any supporting documents and one electronic copy of the Application and any supporting documents;
16. Please provide the amount of water to be used for the camp as well as the amount of water to be used for drilling;
17. Please provide details on any drilling fluids expected to be used including the MSDS for each chemical;
18. Please provide additional information relating to the legends on the maps, specifically what is PlanSub1 and PlanSub 2;
19. Please provide updated maps reflecting the changes to the project including the additional requested information;
20. Please submit an Engagement Plan – the Engagement Plan is a forward-looking document that details times and approaches to engagement with the appropriate affected parties over the life of the authorization or for larger authorizations, over the life of the project. It should reflect the scope, scale, and context of the project. Please refer

to the MVLWB Engagement and Consultation Policy for further guidance and information.


Based on the initial review of the application you may require a Water Licence. Please review the Northwest Territories Waters Regulations for further assistance.
