An appeal is different than an amendment. An appeal goes through the courts. An amendment is a change to a condition or conditions in your Land Use Permit and a request for an amendment is processed by the MVLWB. Afterwards the proponent has an opportunity to respond to reviewer comments and then the request goes to the Board for a decision.

Hi Gary,

I am pasting below an outline of the process which I sent you last time around:

To amend conditions of a LUP, you need to fill out a [LUP application form](#) for the amendment and provide the following information, preferably as part of your accompanying cover letter:

1. The condition(s) that you wish to amend;
2. The nature of the proposed amendment; and
3. The reasons for the proposed amendment.

Proponents are required to engage affected parties regarding the amendment application prior to submitting the request to the Board. As per the [Engagement Guidelines for Applicants and Holders of Water Licences and Land Use Permits](#), for an amendment to a LUP the minimum engagement required would be written notification to affected parties. Evidence that this engagement has taken place should be included with the amendment application.

Hello Gary,

I believe the Inspectors are working with you to ensure you understand how to respond appropriately to their information request.

In terms of the Land Use Permit, you have the option of applying to amend any of the conditions in your Permit. As you have been through an amendment process once already (to change the due dates for two Plans) I will not go into detail on that process. As for the options of suspending or discontinuing your Land Use Permit, I will reiterate what I mentioned to you in an [email I sent Dec. 30, 2014](#):

- Suspension: Section 35 of the [Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations](#) (Regs) outlines the circumstances under which a suspension may occur. The Board may suspend a permit in 4 situations (see 35.1.a-d of the Regs); before suspending a permit, the Permittee must have an opportunity to be heard by the Board. However, a suspension does not relieve the Permittee from any obligations arising from the Permit.
- Discontinuance: Section 37 of the [Regs](#) outlines the circumstances under which a Permittee could give notice of a discontinuance. As you are currently required to hold a Permit to operate, discontinuing your Permit would mean that operations could not continue.

Thank-you for your response letter dated October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015, but unfortunately your letter fails to adequately address the concerns outlined in our letter dated September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2015. This is the third time we've requested information of you to address the concerns outlined in the September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2014 & August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2015 Inspection Reports. As such, **you are required to provide an adequate response in writing to the Inspector no later than November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015.** Your continued failure to do so may leave the Inspector no other alternative but to issue an **Inspectors Order pursuant to Section 86 of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*.**
