The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) received your request dated June 27, 2018 for an extension to Land Use Permit MV2013J0006. Your request has been reviewed and found to be lacking sufficient information required under subsection 26(6) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR). In order for this request to be considered complete, the following information must be submitted to our office:

1. The length of time being requested for the extension. Please note that you can extend the term of the Permit for a period not exceeding two years. However, if the request is for less than two years, you cannot then request a second extension for the remainder of the two years.
2. A copy of your current Certificate of Corporate Registration from the Government of the Northwest Territories.
3. Any other information which would support the extension request, including the status of the land-use operation.
4. Details regarding engagement specific to this extension request. Please refer to my emails of June 29, 2018, July 27, 2018, and August 3, 2018 for specific direction related to engagement.
