I have repeatedly asked for the information regarding the approved facilities and I got an email from you some time ago telling me to look in the Yellow Pages and I did and there was no relevant information there. You/Dept of Lands/MVLWB must have a list of approved facilities and addresses and ownership and history of who approved them???

I did answer the points that Joe Heron asked but again request that you try to co-ordinate your trips so we can actually walk around together and discuss some of the issues as you are jumping to the wrong conclusions.

We need to address most of them with you./Dept of Lands in detail as you generalize and include pictures of, for example, items that we are stock piling as spare parts including tires.

I agree that some of these should be removed and have stated that we will remove them to an "approved Facility: when we have an opportunity/are operating/have empty back hauls. And that non of these items including empty drums are posing a threat to the environment at this time

At this time we do not have the financial resources to charter air planes to go to the lodge to move empty fuel drums or used parts I have asked several times to be allowed to continue using our incinerator and to burn old fuel as an accelerant and to bury ashes.. maybe we need a meeting with some independant experts to properly address these issues. I have also requested permissio to use oil stained gravel as fill and a dust control on out runway Maybe we need an independant expert to consider this as highways and airports do use these materials.

However

I would like to propose a meeting with you, Dept of Lands and MVLWB reps to follow up on some of these points.

Good day Mr. Jaeb,

Thank-you for your response letter dated October 27th, 2015, but unfortunately your letter fails to adequately address the concerns outlined in our letter dated September 12th, 2015. This is the third time we've requested information of you to address the concerns outlined in the September 10th, 2014 & August 11th, 2015 Inspection Reports. As such, **you are required to provide an adequate response in writing to the Inspector no later than November 15th, 2015.** Your continued failure to do so may leave the Inspector no other alternative but to issue an **Inspectors Order pursuant to Section 86 of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act.**

For any concerns you may have regarding Conditions within Land Use Permit MV2013J0006, you may direct your inquiries to Ms. Miki Ehrlich at the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board at 867-766-7649.
