Until the equipment is removed, an approved Storage Authorization must be in place.

**If not submitted to the Board, you can anticipate an Inspector's Order on or about September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 (land use permit expiry date).**

For your information, every person who contravenes any provision of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations* or an Order of an Inspector is guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding \$100,000.00, six months in jail, or both. An offence that is committed or continued more than one day constitutes a separate offence for each day on which it is committed or continued.

This will be my last response on this matter, and once again, your cooperation is anticipated.

Good morning Gary & Malcolm,

As discussed and documented in the August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Environmental Inspection Report, since a new land use permit will not be in place prior to the expiry of land use permit MV2013J0006, the Permittee must apply for a storage authorization for the self-propelled motorized machines (front end loaders, grader, and small tracked dozer), the end dump, and fuel that is currently stored in the land use area.

The submission of the Storage Authorization Form (Attached) is a

requirement of Section 15, Section 16(1) and Section 16(2) of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations* (Regulations).

**True North Safaris' (Permittee) cooperation to comply with provisions of the Regulations is anticipated and appreciated. Failure to submit the required application form to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board will leave the Inspector no other option but to issue an Inspector's Order pursuant to Section 86 of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*.**
