1. A community involvement log which includes detailed minutes of all meetings held and all other correspondence;

Details of the meetings should include:

- When contact was first initiated;
- The nature, dates, and locations of meetings held;
- A list of groups represented at the meetings;
- A list of the issues raised by the stakeholders; and
- An indication of how the issues were addressed in the application.



Provide a listing, including the dates, of any phone calls or other means that may have been used to provide information about the project and to hear any interests or concerns of First Nations with respect to your development;
