Thank you for submitting the final return for Quarry Permit No. 2014QP0027, dated December 5, 2016. Your final return has been reviewed by our Inspector and deemed to be correct.

As you were authorized to remove 1000 cubic metres of gravel under this permit and report that 2473 cubic metres was taken, an additional amount of \$2,209.50 is due to the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT). On December 6, 2016, the additional amount of \$2,209.50 was paid and Receipt Number 134008 (attached) refers to this payment.

Specific to over quarrying, I note from our Inspectors' report dated August 9, 2016, you were advised of Conditions No. 1 and No. 13 of your quarry permit which state:

*1. The permit shall expire when the quantity of material or substance mentioned in the permit has been quarried or removed, or on the expiry date of the permit, whichever is the earlier;*

*13. A permittee who over-quarries may be ineligible for future quarry permits for a twelve month period and additional legal action may be taken by the Land Use Inspector under the Quarrying Regulations.*
