**Water Licence and Land Use Permit Applications– Complete
Mine Site Remediation - Bullmoose Area**

The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) received supporting information for your applications for a Type B Water Licence (WL) and Type A Land Use Permit (LUP) on June 6, 2016. Your WL application will be processed in accordance with the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act* (MVRMA) and the *Waters Act*. Your LUP application will be processed in accordance with paragraph 22(1)(b) of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations* (MVLUR).

Following review of the WL application, the MVLWB will take one of the following actions:

1. Issue a Type B licence, subject to any conditions included under section 72 of the MVRMA;
2. Order that a hearing be held, under section 72.15 of the MVRMA;
3. Refer the Application to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (MVEIRB) for an environmental assessment under subsection 125(1) of the MVRMA; or
4. Where a requirement set out in section 61 or 62 of the MVRMA has not been met, refuse to issue a licence.

Following review of the LUP application, within 42 days of the date of this letter, the MVLWB will take one of the following actions:

1. Issue a Type A permit, subject to any conditions included under subsection 26(1) of the MVLUR;
2. Order, under section 24 of the MVRMA, that a hearing be held or further studies or investigations be made respecting the lands proposed to be used in the land-use operation;
3. Refer the application to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board for an environmental assessment under subsection 125(1) of the MVRMA; or
4. Where a requirement set out in section 61 or 62 of the MVRMA has not been met, refuse to issue a permit.
