**Land Use Permit & Water Licence Applications – Incomplete  
Bullmoose-Ruth Remediation Project**

The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) received your applications for a Land Use Permit and Water Licence on May 18, 2016. Your applications have been reviewed and found to be lacking sufficient information to conduct a preliminary screening. In order for this Application to be considered complete and forwarded for review, the following information must be submitted to our office:

1. An Engagement Plan, including an Engagement Log, which includes copies of all correspondence and minutes of all meetings held between yourselves and communities and Aboriginal groups and First Nations organizations listed in Table 1.

- a. When contact was first initiated;
- b. The nature, dates, and locations of meetings held;
- c. A list of groups represented at the meetings;
- d. A list of the issues raised by the stakeholders; and
- e. An indication of how the issues were addressed in the application;

If you are unable to contact and meet with any of these Aboriginal groups or First Nations, please provide the reason(s) as to why the meeting(s) could not be held. Provide a listing, including the dates, of any phone calls or other means that may have been used to provide information about the project and to hear any interests or concerns of First Nations with respect to your development;
