To whom it may concern;

My Name is Stacey Sundberg-Drygeese, I am a member of the Yellowknives Dene First Nation, and I am from Dettah. I lived in the community my whole life and know the importance of our Wiiliideh Cultural traditions, our values and our commitment to the land and water of Chief Drygeese Territory. My Family in Dettah have a long history of utilizing this area for harvesting, camping, fishing and trapping. I have been to our family cabin since I was born in the 80s.

It came to my attention that there will be a proposed Winter Road through Campbell Lake. As much as the government knows about this area and what it contains. I believe the consequences of this Ice road maybe a hazard to the lake and to our family cabin. With roads, we all know it will be used by people who will come through and try to destroy or use places that don't belong to them. And we have seen this kind of activity going out on the land from Yellowknife to Campbell.

In the winter of 2004 I had set snares in this area and it was taken down by the Squad from the Canadian Military. If this ice road goes through, I know for a fact that this will happen more often not only to us but all the other people in the area.

My Grandfather always told me, if you build roads anywhere, the government will say they built it and now they own it, and because I believe my grandfather. I will not let this happen to an area that our family uses every season for harvesting and feeding our family.

There needs to be a meeting set up regarding the proposed ice road, with all the people that use that area and people from our community of Dettah and Ndilo.
