Hi Kierney (Jen) and Tim,

As you know, the GLG project wishes to seek approval to commence with hauling of waste rock to the Camlaren tailings containment area as soon as regulatory approvals will allow. The detailed construction plan was submitted today and we have requested to reduce the submission deadline as per part D Item 6 of our Water Licence from 45 days to 5 days prior to commencement of construction activities.

As per part D Item 8 of the License, written notice must also be given a minimum of 10 days prior to commencement of construction. I am writing to also request that this timeline be reduced to 5 days to match the request for Part D Item 6.

Also, I wish to formally notify both the board and inspector that DNV plan to commence with hauling of waste rock to Camlaren as early as February 13th (5 days from now) pending the above noted approvals.

The Board is going to be in town next week for the MVRMA workshop, and we could try to hold a quick meeting on February 13th to accommodate a more immediate decision.
