From recent discussions with colleagues, it is my understanding that for federal projects, the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development should be used as the correct reference for legal documents, and Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada should be used for general correspondence. Recently, it was noted that Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada was listed as an applicant for the Gordon Lake Group [LUP](#) and [WL](#) applications. The proponent's name is copied from what is listed on the application form, so we want to ensure that we use the correct legal name for the permit and licence. Can you please confirm if it should in fact be the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development or if the name provided on the applications is to be used (INAC)?
