Your Land Use Permit will be expiring on July 5, 2021. You do have the option to extend the permit, however you will need to submit a request.

An extension request is pretty simple and can come in the form of an email or letter, below are the items that you will need to include in the letter:

1. The reason for the extension request;
2. The length of time the permittee is requesting for the extension (you can apply for a maximum of up to two years);
3. Any other information which would support the extension request; and
4. An engagement record for the extension. Refer to the [Engagement Guidelines](#) for further direction.

If you need help with finding the correct parties to engage with I am happy to assist. Please note that the request must be received prior to the expiry date of the Permit.
