Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada ("INAC") provides the following response to IR #5:

- a) INAC confirms that a single land use permit and a single water licence will be required for the entire project;
- b) Federal inspectors will enforce the water licence and land use permit inasmuch as those apply to that portion of the project located on federal lands. Inspectors employed by the GNWT will enforce the water licence and permit as they apply to those portions of the project located on lands under the administration and control of the Commissioner of the NWT (specifically portions of the winter road to the site from the Joint Venture--Tibbitt to Contwoyto Winter Road, the West Lower Pond Borrow Area, the Airstrip Quarry Area, and the Esker near the old Treeline Lodge). Federal inspectors will regularly consult, cooperate, and coordinate with GNWT inspectors throughout the life of the project; and
- c) The federal Minister of INAC will be the only minister who will approve the Water Licence issued for the project.
