Good Afternoon,

As per condition C.8 of LUP MV2016X0011, I would like to inform you that our remediation contractor (DNV) intends to commence the Tundra Mine 2019 winter program on January 14th. As per usual, this will commence with opening of the camp and construction of the spur road from the main JV road. DNV's current plan is to have a subcontractor clear the MacKay Lake portion of spur road, and DNV will construct the portion of the spur from MacKay Lake to the Tundra camp.

Jared Buchko (DNV) will remain as the primary contact in charge of field operations, with Gord

Peckford currently designated as the Superintendent for the 2019 winter program. Both Jared and Gord can be reached via email, and have been cc'd on this email. Jared is available by phone at 780-667-5511. We will provide the site phone number to the Inspectors once the camp communication has been reestablished.

As per condition C.7 of the LUP, we will be sure to have DNV's Field Supervisor provide CIRNAC and GNWT Inspectors with 48 hours notice prior to mobilizing to site.
