Pine Point Mining Limited (PPML) is pleased to submit the attached application for an amendment to Land Use Permit MV2017C0024 to conduct mineral exploration activities in the Pine Point District. The **nature** of the amendment application is to add some recently registered claims to the existing exploration program currently permitted under MV2017C0024. The **reason** that PPML is requesting this amendment is we have an interest in conducting additional mineral exploration work on lands adjacent to, or in close proximity to, some of our existing leases and claims. We are not requesting that any **conditions** of the Land Use permit be changed; this amendment would simply allow the currently permitted activities to occur on additional lands in the project area.

We understand that this amendment request is allowable under Subsection 26.4 of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations because we are not proposing a change in scope. And we believe the request is consistent with the Rationale for Permit Condition #7 ("Location of Activities") provided by the Board when the Draft permit was issued. The Board's rationale for Condition #7 was as follows: "*The Permittee must submit, for approval, a written request, along with maps, for an amendment to this condition when changes to the area of operation are necessary. Private land, mineral claims, land claims, cultural sites, or other interests in land could be affected.*" Please note that we have complied with the Permit Amendment requirements of the approved Engagement Plan for MV2017C0024.

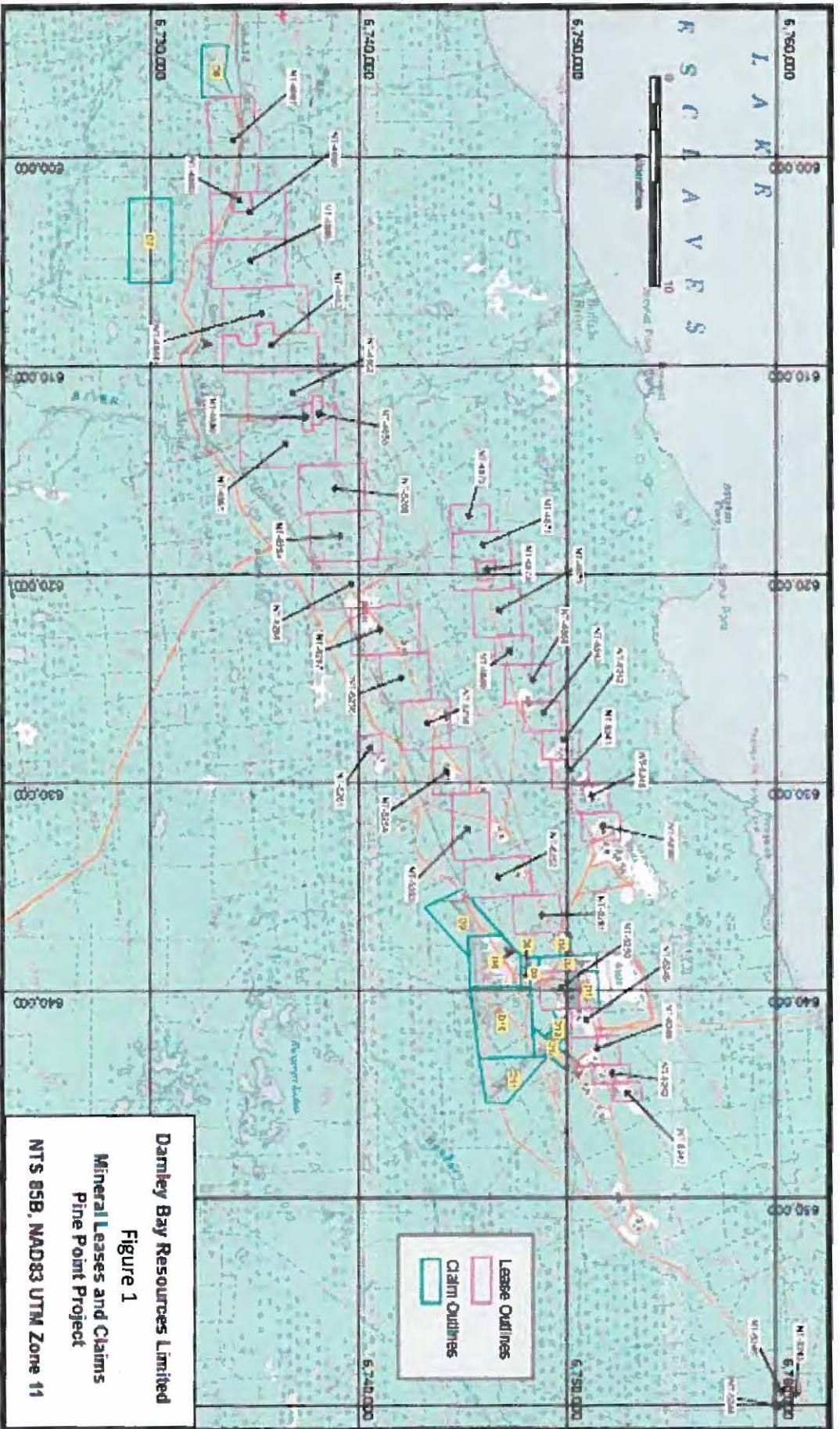
