Hi Misty,

Thank you for providing this letter for the Board's consideration. I spoke with Richard Lafferty this afternoon, and he asked that I share the information I told him on the phone by email with you.

The Board's Late Comment Policy requires that extension requests be submitted prior to the review comment deadline, which in this case was June 29, 2017. The Board is required by the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations to process a land use permit application within 42 days, unless further studies or investigations are required respecting the lands proposed to be used in the land use operation.

If WPFN would like to submit comments for the Board's consideration, they may do so, however the Board will have to decide whether to accept the late comments or not, as they are being submitted after the review comment deadline. If you could submit any comments by the end of the day tomorrow (Thursday July 6, 2017), it will give the company an opportunity to respond if they choose

to, prior to the Board receiving the application for consideration.

Richard mentioned that WPFN would like to be engaged by Darnley Bay on their activities. Darnley Bay indicated in their Engagement Plan submitted with the application that they made attempts to contact WPFN, but did not receive a response. I will call the company and let them know you would like to speak with them, and give them your contact information.
