Dear Mr. Morse,

Pine Point Mining Limited (PPML) is currently conducting exploration drilling under LUP MV2017C0024, and those drilling activities will continue through this winter. We have decided that our winter drilling program in particular will benefit from having camp facilities available to the drill crews. There are substantial health and safety benefits to be realized by reducing commutes, especially in winter driving conditions. Therefore, we have decided to install temporary camp facilities at Pine Point as allowed under our permit. We plan to use contractors to install and operate the camp this winter, we may extend camp facilities after this winter drill season depending upon our need for additional exploration drilling. The camp facilities that we wish to install will run more smoothly if we are able to obtain some slight modifications to our Waste Management Plan (WMP).

Attached to this letter is a copy of the WMP which includes the revisions we are requesting. The changes are identified at the beginning of the document under the heading "Summary of Changes". The main change that we are requesting is to be able to dispose of greywater at the site into a sump. Under the current plan, greywater must be hauled to Hay River for disposal. To be clear, we are not asking for permission to dispose of untreated sewage at the site, just the greywater from camp sinks, showers, and laundry. Minor changes include clarifying that we will no longer consider disposing of any waste (liquid or solid) in Fort Resolution and adding the use of incinerating toilets to the camp facilities.

Per the requirements of the Engagement Plan for this permit, PPML has contacted all of the Affected Parties in writing to notify them of our intent to request these changes to the WMP (see attached Table). A staff member at KFN followed-up with a clarifying question about sewage disposal; PPML answered the question, and KFN staff then notified PPML that there were no issues related to these revisions.

Please let me know if you have any questions about this request to revise the Waste Management Plan.
