N42 Staging Area

Items on site: boxes for drill cores, hoses, pull trailer, trailer on skids, and a flat deck trailer.
Fuel and chemicals: drill rod grease, lubricating oil, 100lb propane tank, and others.

The staging area was clean and well maintained. There was a sump near the staging area that should be reclaimed when practical.

N42 Drilling

Equipment on site: Mooraka MST 80D, First Aid Truck, 4 pickup trucks, 3 trailers on skids, John Deere 700J, drill on tracks, and a water truck.

Fuel and chemicals: None observed. The fuel and chemicals were stored for transport.

During the inspection Foraco was moving the equipment to a new hole in N42. The drilled holes had not been cut or capped yet as per Condition 16 of the Land Use Permit.
