Dear Mr. Sunderland,

An inspection of the entire length of the winter road was conducted on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018 by Inspector Clint Ambrose. The Permittee provided Inspectors 10 day notification of seasonal closure of the winter road (Condition #8) on April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and therefore an inspection was conducted to ensure the conditions annexed to the above noted Land Use Permit were adhered to during this land use operation.

No environmental concerns were noted during the inspection and with the impending closure of the winter road, there does not appear to be any further work required by the Permittee with the exception of sign removal.

As per the February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Environmental Inspection Report and Condition #27 of the land use permit, the Permittee was to provide a log of all small spills to the Inspectors once the winter road was ploughed to width and portage construction complete.

This log still has not been received which is unacceptable and must be submitted to Inspectors no later than **midnight on April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018**. Failure to do so may leave the Inspector no other option but to initiate further enforcement action pursuant to Section 86(2) of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*.
