Issuance of Quarry Permit at Fort Resolution Airport Pit

This letter is to inform you that the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) Department of Lands is issuing a quarry permit at the Fort Resolution Airport Pit.

BACKGROUND

The quarry pit located North of the Fort Resolution airport runway has existed for many years and Quarry Reserve 85 H/4-77-2 was established February 15, 2012. The applicant is requesting to remove 18,200 cubic metres of gravel (pit run material) from this location. It is important to note that the Department of Lands previously consulted on the Quarry Reserve application December 22, 2011, and these same boundaries are not proposed to change for this quarry operation.
