Issuance of Quarry Permit at Km 188.4 (L), off Mackenzie Highway (NWT No. 1)

This letter is to inform you that the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) Department of Lands is issuing a quarry permit at Km 188.4 (L), off Mackenzie Highway (NWT No. 1).

BACKGROUND

A quarry permit was last issued at this site on August 7, 2009, during the Dehcho Bridge construction. The applicant is requesting 150,000 cubic metres of pit run gravel from this location for highway operations and maintenance of the public highway. It is important to note that the Department of Lands previously consulted on the quarry site and the boundaries remain within the approved land use area.
