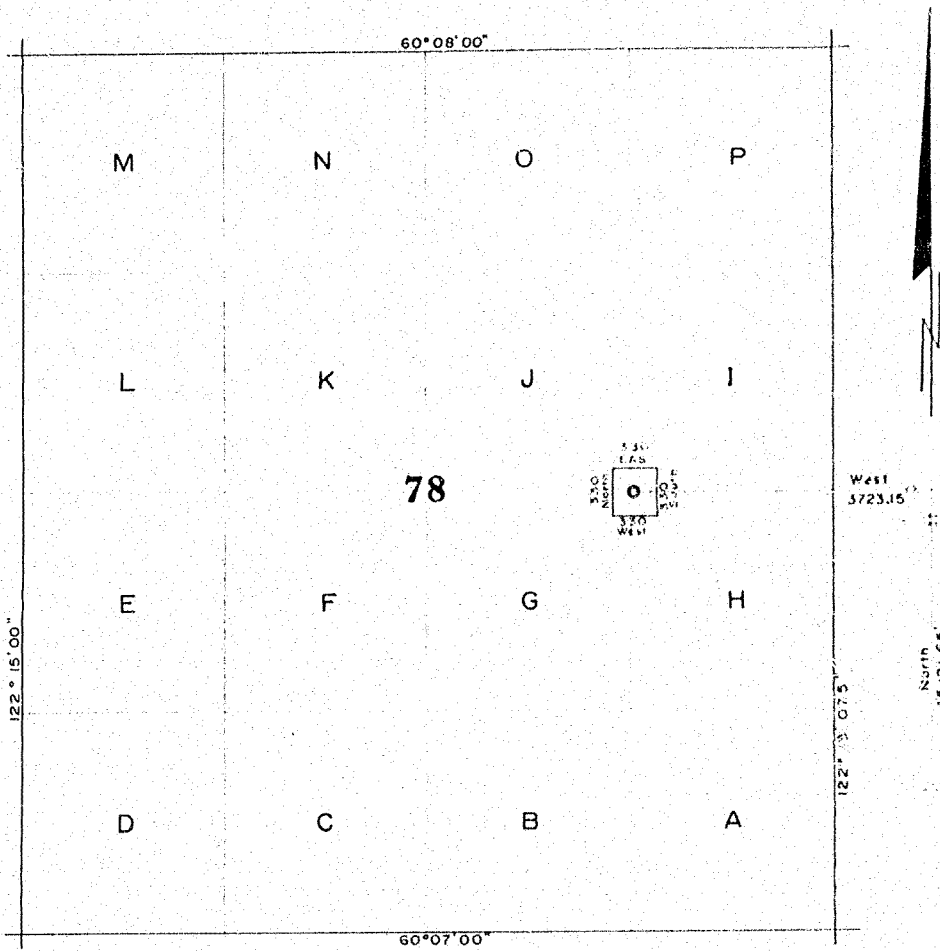


PLAN OF WELL LOCATION
