Thanks very much for submitting the Water Licence application for Samba K'e First Nation!

I've just finished doing a completeness check, and everything is there except for one detail, which is the Licence term that SKFN would like to apply for. The legislation allows for Type B Licenses to be granted for up to 25 years, though the MVLWB hasn't yet granted a term that long. Municipal Licences tend to be granted in the range of about 10 years, but you are free to apply for the term you want, and it may be discussed by reviewers during the application review process.

An email to me, specifying SKFN's desired term will work fine; I will post it to the registry and include it as a link when I post the rest of the application for review. If you could send that email in the next few days, that would be much appreciated.
