Purpose

This technical workshop is being held as part of the water licence application process for the Sambaa K'e First Nation Water Licence Application.

This workshop will provide an opportunity for parties to pose and discuss their technical comments and questions about the applications directly with the proponent (Sambaa K'e First Nation) and/or its consultants. It is Board Staff's hope that such a discussion, as facilitated by Board staff, will increase each party's understanding of the issues as well as of the perspectives of others. The goal is to foster a better understanding of the municipal facilities and any outstanding issues for Board staff and reviewers prior to the distribution of a draft water licence for review. Certain technical issues identified in the application review as well as logistical and practical considerations for the Sambaa K'e First Nation will be discussed. The draft water licence will be distributed for review following the workshop.

Please note that the technical workshop will not be transcribed, and Board members and their legal counsel will not be participating. The intent is that the workshop be as informal as possible in order to promote discussion and inform the draft water licence that will be circulated for review.
