Good afternoon Jacqueline; In discussions with ENR this afternoon it appears there will not be a conflict with the 2 land use permits being requested (Town of Hay River & GNWT) for the same lands. The dredging the Town is requesting is from a location deemed to be Commissioner's Land and will be placed on Commissioner's Land. The Town of Hay River are dredging a recreational area used seasonally by MTS to store barges in the winter. ENR have requesting sampling the soils where the dredged materials will be placed prior to dumping the material. They have a few details they will need to work out and we request you work directly with Andrea Ellis to coordinate the applications for permits. Thanks, Gary


Hi Gary,

As I mentioned on the phone this morning, the MVLWB has received two applications that may be conflicting each other. The GNWT-ENR has applied for a Permit to conduct environmental site assessment in Hay River, and the Town of Hay River has applied for a Licence to do dredging, and is proposing to place the dredged material on Lot 1057 Plan 977 (see lot highlighted below), which is a subset of GNWT's proposed project area.

The Town of Hay River states in their application that Lot 1057 Plan 977 is their land, but it is currently commissioner's land. Tom from MTS mentioned something about getting a lease renewed, so I'm not exactly sure what's happening there. It would be great if you could let me know what the status of that Lot is. The GNWT's Permit Application is a little bit more urgent as it has a 42-day legislative timeline.

Thank you for your help. I really appreciate it.
