**Information Request - Re Town of Hay River Water Licence MV2018L7-0002 Application – Land Tenure – Porritt Landing Dredging Project**

On June 27, 2018, the Town of Hay River (Town)'s Water Licence Application MV2018L7-0002 for its Porritt Landing Dredging Project was distributed for review on the [Online Review System](#). The Town has proposed to deposit dredged material on Lot 1057, Plan 977, which is Commissioner's Land. Review comment #2 by Government of Northwest Territories Department of Lands (GNWT-Lands) indicates that the Town does not currently have land tenure on Lot 1057, Plan 977 and therefore eligibility has not been met. On [June 26, 2018](#) and [August 1, 2018](#), Board staff received e-mails from GNWT-Department of Infrastructure indicating that there is no conflict with the Town depositing dredged material on Lot 1057, Plan 977.

In order for the Board to consider the Application, a coordinated response from both GNWT departments is required. Board staff is requesting GNWT to provide a response by 5:00 PM, Friday August 17, 2018. If this timeline cannot be met, please provide a suggested timeline as soon as possible.
